GYNAECOLOGICAL SURGERY, PRINCIPLES AND PRACTICES, by Dr. A. V. Kerkar (Chitra Publications).

This book is an outcome of a rich experience of the author. He has used his wisdom, warmth and wit in presenting this practical Indian experience in gynaecological surgery.

This book has two sections, first section deals with general consideration, technique of sterilisation, pre and post operative preparation, management and complication. The second section deals with varities of operations for different genital organs. Here author has also

shown his personal views and technical re-adjustments to the 'standard' methods which are useful and good guides to beginners. The presentation is simple and lucid.
