POSTGRADUATE REPRODUCTIVE ENDOCRINOLOGY: Published by Prof. R. Rajan, M.D., Head of the Infertility Unit, Medical College, Kottayam (Kerala), and Chairman—"Infertility Committee of FOGSI.

The First Edition is a valuable contribution to this important field of our speciality. The Book comprises of 30 chapters well spaced out over about 600 pages.

The last decade has witnessed the establishment and acceptance of sophisticated diagnostic procedures, and medications which have helped to revolutionise treatment modalities. It is now within the reach of clinicians to manipulate hormones with the object of controlling reproductive performance to achieve goals and objectives planned for individual patients.

The book deals with the basic principles of endocrinology to enable the student to acquire a firm foundation. Further chapters deal with the biology and pharmacology of the hormones influencing the reproductive process.

After familiarising the student with the basics of reproductive endocrinology, Dr. Rajan goes on to the therapeutic applications of investigational methods like hormone assays and ultrasonography. He has lucidly elaborated on the diagnostic values of these tests and their importance in monitoring therapy.

In my opinion, the particular highlights of this book are chapters 16, 19, and 21 in which he illustrates his teachings by alluding to his own personal experiences with the commonly used drugs. These chapters are a must for all practitioners of our speciality. The nuances of the art of hormonal manipulation and its finer aspects which help in acquiring expertise leading to excellent results well brought out by him.

In clinical practice, the male factor contributes substantially to the infertile state in almost a third of our cases. Dr. Rajan has meticulously dealt with this important facet of the problem in chapters 29 and 30.

Finally the foundations for those who wish to indulge in In-vitro fertilisation and GIFT are well laid out in chapter 28 of this book.

I congratulate the author on this magnificent publication. It is a must for all students wishing to specialise in obstetrics and gynaecology. For those who specialise in infertility, this book by a master of the art would be a compendium for ready reference to find answers to vexatious clinical problems.

I recommend that all medical libraries should have this book on their shelves for easy accessibility.
