Dr. C. L. Jhaveri was born in Ahmedabad, Gujarat on 3rd Sept, 1911. He passed M.B.B.S. (Bom.) in 1947, and M.D. with Midwifery and Gynaecology in 1950 from The Grant Medical College Bombay.

He was appointed as an Honorary Obstetrician and gynaecologist at Balabhai Nanavati Hospital in 1951. This Institution is recognised for Post Graduate Studies by the College of Physicians and Surgeons and the University of Bombay. In 1955 he established a separate Department for Family Planning with the grants received from Government of India at the Nanavati Hospital. In 1965 he was admitted to the Fellowship of American College of Surgeons.

He was the member of the Medical faculty, University of Bombay, since 1953 and a member of Senate, since 1964, Member Governing Council of College of Physicians and Surgeons since 1954 and its President for the year 1968-69. He was the Member, Medical Council of India, elected in 1966 to represent Medical Graduates, Maharashtra State and re-elected in 1972 for a further period of 5 years.

He was the National Secretary of the International Fertility Association, Member World Fertility Council in 1962 and Vice-President International Fertility Association in 1968.

He was Honorary General Secretary of Federation of Obstetric and Gynaecological Societies of India from 1967 to 1974. He was President of FOGSI in year 1975-76. He was a Member of Executive Committee, International Federation of Gynaecology and Obstetrics from 1970 to 1976. He edited two volumes published by the Federation of Obstetric and Gynaecological Societies of India on Maternal Mortality, Family Planning and Biology of Reproduction in 1969 & 1975 and Infertility proceedings of the 16th All India Congress in 1973.

He was awarded Dr. B.C. Roy award in 1985. He was The Founder President of Indian Association of Fertility and Sterility, and of Indian Academy of Juvenile and Adolescent Gynaecology.

He expired on 6-10-1996.
