## A Rare Case of Forgotten Needle in the Epsiotomy

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Mrs. M, 28 years old para 1 was admitted with complaints of continuous pain at the episiotomy site, difficulty in sitting and difficulty in passing motion. She had delivered one month back, in the military hospital.

Hardness was felt in the posterior vaginal wall and a foreign body was suspected. X-ray showed a broken needle in the area (Figure. 1). Exploration was carried out under G.A. and the anterior half of the broken cutting needle was removed and recovery was uneventful.

On examination episiotomy site was healed.
